Wheatfields Nursery provides childcare to children aged 2-5 years of age. We are registered with Ofsted and the nursery is a member of the Early Years Alliance (EYA). The nursery follows the Early Years Foundation Stage standards and guidance for learning.

The supervisors and staff hold childcare qualifications, and all staff hold current DBS checks. Staff, committee and trustees follow various policies to ensure the safety and wellbeing of children and adults.

The running of the nursery is managed by a voluntary committee elected by parents/carers. The committee/trustees have regular meetings throughout the year to discuss feedback from staff, the running of the nursery, maintenance issues and to plan fundraising activities.

Committee members and trustees are also DBS checked. They give their time and experiences voluntarily to the running of the nursery and receive no remuneration or benefits.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year	During this year, we have provided childcare and education to a total of 43 children. Of these, 24 children have completed their nursery journey and will begin school in September 2018.
	Fundraising events have raised £1982.45 this year. Of this £1397.82 was spent on new tables and chairs for the nursery and new play equipment for the children – replacing many items that were in poor condition. A mud kitchen for the children was also created in the outside space.

Children not yet eligible for funded hours pay a fee per session which is due half termly in advance. Other funds are provided through a variety of fundraising events throughout the year.
