The objects of the Society are to advance public education, and foster a general interest, in model railways, prototype railways and allied pursuits and to encourage a high standard of railway modelling – in particular, amongst the members of the Society.

In accordance with Section 17(5) of the Charities Act and the Charities (Accounts and Reports) Regulations 2008, the trustees have had regard to the guidance on public benefit, issued by the Charity Commission when exercising any powers or duties to which the guidance may be relevant. All trustees have read the guidance and take it into account at their regular meetings and in planning the organisation's activities.

The Society provides facilities to develop skills and knowledge to construct working railway models and to research prototype railways. It provides educational instruction on the methods and tools that can be used in construction of the models.

The Society organises a model railway exhibition to promote and encourage public interest in model railways.

Talks on aspects of model construction and operation of protype railways are open to members of the Society and also to interested members of the public

Members of the Society support other model railway clubs/societies by taking model railway layouts to exhibitions or providing demonstrations of skills and activities in model making.

## Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The society held regular Wednesday evening meeting throughout the year, with the objective of building skills and knowledge in the construction and operation of model railways. This includes a wide range of skill, carpentry, design, low voltage electrics, model building and scenic work. Also research in connection with historic prototype railways, their operation and train services and rolling stock.

An annual model railway show was held over a weekend in a local school to show case railway modelling to the wider public and to promote general interest. A diverse range of layouts included 'hands on' experience for children through to examples of skilled craftsmanship.

A number of evening lectures were held in the clubrooms, which were advertised more widely for the benefit of non-members. Plans have been put in place for an entry free Open Day in the clubrooms to enable members of the public to appreciate the activities of railway modelling, showcasing the societies operational layouts and those under construction.

Society members have also taken our award winning layout to a number of Model Railway Shows, as well as supporting individual members taking their personal layouts to Shows.

A similar programme of events is planned for the forthcoming year.
