Ramadhan

Ramadhan gift packs

During Ramadan, Muslims fast from sunrise to sunset as an act of devotion to Allah Almighty and self-constraint. Many of us know that we will have a plentiful supply of food and water to break our fast. However, across the world, many families struggle to put food on the table at iftar time. With rising food prices, household poverty and long working hours whilst fasting, many families instead have little food and worry about how they will feed their families.

We work with people and communities to ensure that families have enough food for the month of Ramadan. Across the globe, we distribute family food packs with essentials such as flour, rice, and lentils to last the whole month, meaning families can instead focusing on the spiritual duties of the month.

Yearly, Bismillah Aid provided Food Rations and Gift Packs to associates NGO Bismillah Welfare Trust. Food ration included daily used products such as Flour, Ghee (Butter, Daals (Lentils), Sugar, Dry Milk, Rice, and other necessary stuff. Apart from this, Gift Packs included toys, new clothes, books and stationary for the kids. NGO Bismillah Welfare Trust then distributed these food and gift packs amongst the hundreds of poor, needy and poverty-stricken families and orphaned children in the region of districts throughout the world.

Ramadhan Month package

Ramadhan of 2018, £150 provided a family with a Ramadhan Food Pack containing a whole month's supply of essentials.

We received enough donations to provide for our Muslim brothers and sisters to receive a nourishing Iftaar and Suhoor meal for each day of Ramadhan.

Yearly, your donations ensure that hundreds of families across Pakistan, Nepal, India etc, through your donations get to enjoy a health and hunger free Eid. Many of these families rarely consume meat, but thanks to your donations, we were able to feed hundreds of vulnerable families around the world during Eid-ul-Adha this year.
