CHARITY COMMISSION ANNUAL REPORT

YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2019

The year just ended was the first full year of operation of Thompson Community Hall. We started the year with the official opening of the Hall, to which all households in Thompson were invited together with those who had been involved in the planning and construction of the building. Baroness Shephard of Northwold, our former MP, cut the ribbon.

Although most of the fitting out of the hall had taken place between completion of construction in December 2017 and the end of the previous financial year, a few were still outstanding at the beginning of the year which were completed by the end of the first quarter. External landscaping was started, though the hot dry summer made the work difficult and much of the lawned area had to be recleared and reseeded in the autumn. Native species hedging was planted which we hope will provide colour and attract wildlife. Over the winter we constructed a petanque court, which we were able to fund through a variety of grants.

The first year of the new Community Hall has been a great success. We have a variety of regular users and the hall has been hired for a large number of private functions. Additionally, the Trustees have arranged fund arranging events to provide a diversity of functions for the village and the surrounding area. We have therefore been successful in generating a small surplus of income over expenditure for standard activities, completion of the hall and exceptional costs coming from the construction budget and grant funding.

We are looking forward to building on this success in the coming years.
