#### Annual report 2017-18

79 children enjoyed meeting our ponies, helping to care for them and benefiting from the physical and mental therapy we provide. Of the 79 children, 34 were new to us mostly from schools where whole classes are brought by school transport, together with class staff.

All the children present different challenges for us. We monitor progress after each session, and we calculate the difference made by each one.

Within our 44 volunteers, 14 are all under the age of 25. On Saturday mornings they combine their help with the ponies and children using their time with us to complete their Duke of Edinburgh Awards, also the Young Equestrian Leaders Awards (YELA).

After an anxious financial situation in 2017 the generosity of so many people has been humbling, from family trusts, rotarians, supermarkets, the lottery and Northamptonshire Community Foundation. These sources were all negotiated by our Trustees and friends. But a special mention must go to Wendy, our 72 year old volunteer of many years who undertook a sky dive, raising over £1,000.

So the future looks bright and our work will continue for the foreseeable future. We thank especially our volunteers, without whom we could not operate.
