ANNUAL REPORT For the year ended 31 December 2018

Organisational structure

The Trustees met on five occasions during the year to consider the management and maintenance of the Charity's property, monitor the financial position and consider any other matters concerning the Charity. All financial transactions require the signature of two Trustees or officers.

All trustees, secretary and treasurer remained in office as the previous year (2017).

Activities

- Property: Four cottages and the Institute care taker's cottage were fully let during
 the year. Minor repairs and improvements have been carried out as necessary.
 Cottage rents were reviewed and selective small increases made. Smoke and CO
 detectors were checked or fitted. Decorating and some new carpeting was carried
 out on no. 4 A structural survey of part of the exterior stone walling was carried out
 to confirm its stability.
- 2. A limited gift was made to a struggling village family from the Hardship fund. (formally the Christmas distribution)
- 3. Land: The tenancy of the fields at Petsoe remained unchanged.
- 4. Hiring rates for the Institute (hall) were reviewed and small selective increases were made. Exterior redecoration and minor repairs were carried out on the hall and caretakers cottage.

Grants and gifts

The value of grants and gifts made during the year were:

£1,800 Educational grants.

£300 Senior citizens Christmas lunch.

£236 charitable gifts.

Accounts

 Income from hall lettings remained steady. Routine required inspections were carried out. The value of the Charity's investments and income received remained satisfactory during the year. Cash investments are in recognised charitable funds – COIF and M&G.

- 2. The Charity received by right seven tenths of the income from the K A H Sams Charitable Fund quarterly. The income increased satisfactorily during the year.
- 3. The value of the Charity's investments is shown on the balance sheet.
- 4. The value of the Charity's buildings and land is shown on the balance sheet.

Description of trust

The Trust provides and maintains a village hall.

Financial assistance to residents under 25 years for vocational education or training

The Trustees administer seven tenths of the income of the K A H Sams Charitable Fund, which provides "for such charitable purposes for the benefit of the inhabitants of Emberton".
