Friends of All Saints' Brixworth is registered with the Charity Commissioners (number 295881) and is constituted by a Trust Deed dated 28<sup>th</sup> January 1986, amended 7th October 2008.

The Charities Act 2006 requires specific identification of 'public benefit'. The Trustees confirm that the objectives and aims, as described below, fall within the following charitable purposes - The 'advancement of culture and heritage' and the 'advancement of religion'.

The objectives of the charity are currently to maintain, improve, supplement and keep in repair the fabric, fittings, furniture and furnishings of the Parish Church of All Saints' Brixworth and its churchyard and Heritage Centre. The Friends of All Saints' Brixworth also aim to foster interest in the Parish Church from near and far, not only as a place of worship but also for its significance to the area's local heritage.

## Review of the year and future developments

The Trustees consider that the charity adequately fulfilled their 2018 objectives with respect to church projects which concentrated mainly upon support to church maintenance. The Friends have been very active with fundraising projects including a Curry & Quiz Evening, a Ladies Lunch with speaker on "Women in Art", and the Annual Brixworth Lecture. The refurbishment of the church organ was finally completed in January and an Organ Recital took place in May to celebrate its new lease of life. The clock face on the tower was repainted and gilded and the damaged areas of stonework on the exterior of the church, identified by the architect in the Quinquennial Report, were replaced. The Friends were pleased to help the PCC with funds to a total of £22,198 towards these items.

The income from the hire of the Heritage Centre and the sale of publications remains two of our most stable forms of income.

The liaison between The Friend's Board of Trustees', the PCC, Vicar and Churchwardens is cordial and therefore our approach to supporting the Church fabric is all the better for it.

The need to reinvigorate the membership, both in numbers and participation, is still an ongoing objective. Whilst support for the Friends' activities remains high, persuading people to sign up as members is still a challenge.

Finally, the Trustees wish to acknowledge the contribution of associated members towards the annual events and activities; the History Society for their continuing collaboration in both display material and staffing of the Heritage Centre and Jack, our Website master

## **Finance Report**

The Cash, Bank, and Investment balance at 31st December 2018 is approximately £35k. Total assets including buildings amount to approximately £241K. The Charities' income during 2018 was comparable with that of 2017. The Charity has held a small capital reserve in COIF Charities Investment Fund for several years, and acknowledges that owing to the current financial situation, the growth that has been achieved over this period has not been very strong.

## Trustees

Trustee Nigel Turpin resigned at the AGM in June. Our thanks go to him for his support. In November we welcomed Mrs Caroline Monk as a Trustee, she has taken up the role of Secretary and we wish her every success in that role.

This report, together with the Treasurer's report and accounts was presented at the Annual Report Meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2018.
