#### Cromwell District Scout Council -Trustees Annual Report for the year ended 31st December 2018

What does scouting bring to our young people in this modern age of technology, the answer fun, lots of ideas and many life skills that will stay with them all through their adult lives

In this respect my thanks go out to all the leaders in Cromwell District for the exciting programmes they produce to ensure that scouting remains relevant to our young people

Over half of our Explorer Scouts now work as Young Leaders within the Colonies, Packs & Troops around the District and their invaluable help is both a credit to themselves and to the leaders they assist.

With Ramwell starting last year the District now have 4 Explorer units and they continue to thrive and work together with joint meetings taking part in a very varied programme of activities, many exciting trips away including allowing them to achieve their individual goals in the Duke of Edinburgh scheme

CMC have been active again in producing opportunities for both scouts over 12.5 years of age and leaders to gain valuable hill walking experience, meet new friends and have fun. The trip to Big rock was very popular as were the trips to Brecon, Glenbrook & Coppermines giving those attending a wide range of terrains to master

The ASU despite having an undisclosed combined age of a figure I wont be disclosing have supported the District Beaver & Cub events together with the monthly District Surgeries

My thanks go to the 7 members of the Appointments Advisory Committee they meet on 12 occasions saw 43 new leaders, considered 25 changes of roles and completed 15 reviews

The Badge Secretary has had another very busy year with the groups purchasing nearly £5,000 worth of badges, just goes to show how busy our leaders are with their youngsters

Our total District membership at census time stood at 1,085 of which 831 are young people, Beavers increased by 22 mainly due to the new Beaver Colony at 2<sup>nd</sup> St Ives, the numbers in Cubs & Scouts both dropped by 6 & 19 respectively and the Explorers increased by 1. Our Adult membership dropped by 5 to 254

With the help of all those that come forwarded to be part of the District Core Teams the District have been able to host for the Beavers the night hike around Hinchingbrooke Park, Sleep overs & the Sausage Sizzle at Copley. For the Cubs their Night Hike at Kings Ripton held in May due to the event in March being postponed due to inclement weather and their swimming event in November. The only all section event was the St George's Day Event held on Slepe Field in St Ives

The receipts for hiring out Copley exceeded £11,000 in 2018 although £300 of that was for 2019 booking deposits. Excluding the weekly use by the District the site saw 1,500 camp nights and 400 sleep over's in the building. As you can imagine that use means a lot of work in maintaining both the site and building and my thanks go out to all those involved in this maintenance. New trees and hedging have been planted thanks to the funding of the 'Tesco Bags of Help' scheme to replace those lost through both natural wastage and storm damage. The online calendar has proved very successful

To conclude I would just like to thank the DC, DDC, ADC's, District Leaders and all those that sit on the District Executive, Appointments committees and core organising teams for their contribution during the last 12 months

The District is a Trust established under its rules that are common to all Districts, and the Trustees are appointed in accordance with the Policy, Organisation & Rules of the Scout Association and The accounts have been drawn up on the receipts and payments basis that is consistent with the previous year and approved by the Trustees on the 18th February 2019 and signed on their behalf by Mike Wenham
