#### **Director's Summary**



Our 2018 year has been very busy, with growth and development in many areas. The Noah Initiative (the UK Charity) has supported The Noah Society (Kenya) with funding which has enabled ongoing support for 61 students in full time learning. This includes vocational training, college, secondary and primary level education and over 40 single mothers and guardians being empowered through our mentorship program.

We have placed great emphasis on growing the student's gifts and talents this year. We are proud to now have a fully-fledged street dance group, whilst two of the boys have recorded songs and are making waves in the Kenyan music industry. We have also held successful football training and tournaments, as well as training the students in visual art.

Some of the guardians have also been selected for training in business management working in collaboration with a fellow charity Ampath.

As we continue to spread our net into the communities we serve we are positively impacting the lives of more people. To support this growth we also have to focus on widening our donor and supporter base.

During the year we held several fundraising events including a Gala Dinner in Collaboration with The High Sheriff of Cumbria attended by over 250 people. We had the opportunity to visit three UK schools and numerous churches.

We hope that as the need continues to rise, we are also able to rise to the challenge.
