To relieve poverty, hardship or distress through the provision of food to people in need of emergency supplies in York and the surrounding area and by such other means as the trustees may determine.

Summary of the main activities in relation to those purposes for the public benefit, in particular, the activities, projects or services identified in the accounts

The collecting of donated food by members of the public, the training of care professionals in giving out emergency food vouchers, the supporting of four local churches (Gateway Church, Living Word Church, York Community Church and York City Church) who run Foodbank sessions where vouchers can be redeemed for three days' worth of food. We continue to rely heavily on the support of a great team of volunteers who give their time to help people in need. We could not function without them.

The trustees consider that they have complied with their duties to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity, identifying the difference the charity's work has made to the circumstances of its beneficiaries and any wider benefits to society as a whole. This year we have continued to operate at a similar level to last year, providing weekly sessions at four separate locations across York. In this financial year we received and distributed 37,793.7kg of food. This was given out to 1,729 voucher holders, representing 2,524 adults and 1,502 children (4,026 individuals in total) over the year. This has contributed to the relief of hardship for many vulnerable families and individuals, who otherwise would have gone hungry.

Our finances continue to remain healthy, with good levels of public giving and low overheads. We ran a small surplus of over £1,500 this year.
