Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

- 1) To promote community participation in healthy recreation in Elswick and the surrounding area, by the provision of facilities to enable people to participate in swimming and other sports and activities which are capable of improving physical health and fitness.
- 2) To promote, for the benefit of the inhabitants of Elswick and the surrounding area, the provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation of individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, financial hardship or social

and economic circumstances or for the public at large in the interests of social welfare and with the object of improving the condition of life of the said inhabitants.

We are working towards re-opening Elswick Pool through negotiations with Newcastle City Council for an agreement to lease the facility, for the purpose of providing swimming and other sports and activities which are capable of improving physical health and fitness.

We have applied for charitable funding to support us in achieving our public benefit objects. The funding is required, as a first stage, to enable us to re-open the facility, safely and permanently, to the public.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Elswick Pool is still protected through an extended 'mothballing' agreement with the City Council, whilst discussions are in progress about an agreement to lease. Without this security and operational protection, the pool would almost certainly be incapable of re-opening to the public as a swimming centre.

We have continued to engage in dialogue with the City Council, with the aim of the board taking on a lease to manage the pool, redesigning and re-opening it, in line with priorities defined through a community survey of 800 residents.

We have continued our effective engagement with the local community through social and mainstream media, as well as through face-to-face community interaction. We have engaged with community organisations, reaching informal co-operation agreements with local charities and service providers.

We have worked with local regeneration organisation Centre West, which has provided in-kind practical and logistical support to the board. Elswick Ward councillors agreed City Council ward funding to pay for additional consultancy support for the board. Discussions have been held with pool operators, with a view to training local people to work in the facility and assisting in its early management.

We registered as a charity 11 August 2017. This is the trustee board's first annual report, approved at its first formal AGM on 8 October 2018.
