# Report of the Management Committee For the year ended 31 December 2018

The management committee present their report together with the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2018.

#### **Objectives**

The charity exists to promote the benefit of the local inhabitants of Hurworth and others without distinction of sex or of political, religious or other opinions, by associating the local authorities, voluntary organisations and the inhabitants in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities in the interest of social welfare for recreation and leisure time occupation with the object of improving the condition of life for the said inhabitants.

#### **Activities**

During 2018 the Association engaged in its main activity of hall rentals together with hosting events such as dances, Christmas and country fairs. The trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit

#### **Achievements and Performance**

Events held during 2018 were well supported and these created a surplus of £14381 towards funding. The main activity of hall rentals generated income of £76632.

#### **Future strategy**

The charity is to establish or secure the establishment of a Community Centre and to maintain and manage, or to co-operate with any local authority in the maintenance and management of such a Centre.

#### Members of the management committee

Members of the management committee, who are trustees for the purpose of charity law, who served during the period and up to the date of this report are set out on page 3. Vacancies are advertised within the village. Potential new members are proposed and seconded by members of the association. They are then voted into committee membership by the current members of the committee. Training is given 'on the job' with mentoring by current members and staff. Paid courses are available on request.

#### Review of the business

The statement of Receipts and Payments on page 7 of these financial statements details all incoming and outgoing resources during the year. The committee considers the charity's affairs to be satisfactory.

#### Reserves policy

The Management Committee has examined the charity's requirements for reserves in light of the main risks to the organisation. It has established a policy whereby the unrestricted funds not committed held by the charity should be 6 months of the running costs of the Centre. The present level of reserves available to the charity meets this target level.

## Risk review
