

Report of the Treasurer Financial

Year Ended 31 July 2018

During the past year, the Parents' Association has reported a surplus of £2,714.40 compared to a deficit in the previous year of £5,017.96.

Donations to the school total £9,896.00, with £300 in support of the school council, a £2,000 contribution to televisions and a £7,596 contribution to acoustic ceiling panels in the school hall roof.

The PA continue to fund a number of other activities in the school including the annual Panto and gifts (£656.00) and Year 6 leavers (£779.35). It has also paid the advanced deposit for the Panto next Christmas.

In terms of profit generating activities for the year, there was the Christmas Fayre and Summer Ball. The Christmas fayre was more profitable than the previous year with a surplus of £4,646.27 and the Summer Ball made a profit of £9,073.00. There was also the Treasure Hunt that took place during the year that raised £24.48.

In addition to parent volunteers that are so important to running the fund-raising events, the PA has received £560 in donations. We would like to thank parents for their support and hope to receive their continued support next year.

We have also maintained our PTA UK membership through which we gain insurance cover for these major events.

As at 31 July 2018, the Parents' Association had a closing bank balance of £7,561.91 and, as such, the Association continues to be well placed to contribute to the well-being of school life and make donations for the benefit of the children.

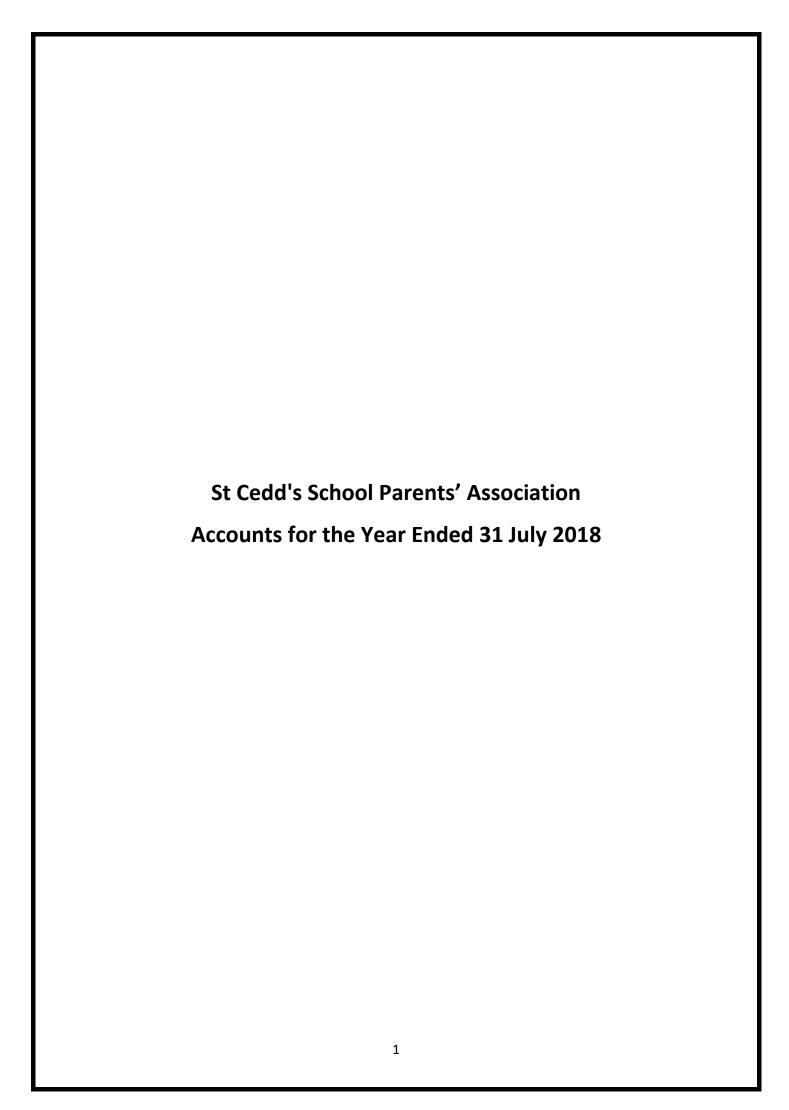
