## **OBJECTIVES**

### **Objectives and Aims**

It constituted a trust deed on 25 September 2014 in view of registering with the Charity Commissioners. On 02 December 2014 Bilal Academy was granted registration as an unincorporated charity (Charity Number 1159456).

Our Doctrine is to promote the teachings of the Quran, the Prophet Muhammad and his companions (peace be upon him and them) as defined and interpreted by the Ahlus-Sunnah Wal Jamma'ah and expounded by the Pious predecessors (peace be upon them).

We aim to advance the education of the public and young people by providing language classes and recreational activities to develop their capabilities that they may grow to become good citizens.

### **CHARITABLE OBJECTS**

- to advance education for the benefit of the poor, the underprivileged and the general public by means of, but not exclusively, the provision or the assistance in the provision of educational activities and facilities, such as supplementary schools and adult learning programmes, for the benefit of the said persons;

- (iii) to relieve financial hardship, distress and suffering among poor people, the disabled, victims of natural and man-made disasters and other people in need, by means of, but not exclusively, making grants or loans for providing or paying for food, clothing, equipment, services and facilities for the benefit of the said persons;
- (iv) to relieve sickness and to preserve good health among the poor, underprivileged and people in need by means of, but not exclusively, the provision or assistance in the provision of services, equipment, medicines or grants for medical diagnosis and treatment, or provision of health education for the benefit of the said persons;
- (v) to provide or assist in the provision of facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation or other leisure time occupation of individuals who have

need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age infirmity or disability, financial hardship or social circumstances with the object of improving their conditions of life.

## **STRUCTURE**

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

The Bilal Academy building requires substantial structural work; during the year a new administration office was created on the ground floor, with major decorating work ongoing.
