2 Election of Trustees

The Trustees are elected on an annual basis. The next Election will be held at the Annual General Meeting in September 2019.

3 The objectives of the charity are:

- a) to relieve the suffering of animals in need of care and attention and in particular to provide and maintain rescue homes or other facilities for the reception and care of such animals.
- b) to promote humane behaviour towards animals by providing appropriate care, protection, treatment and attention by reason of sickness, maltreatment, poor circumstances or ill usage and to educate the public in matters pertaining to animal welfare in general and the prevention of cruelty and suffering among animals.

4 Activities and Achievements

We now seem to have reached the stage where we are a sanctuary for cats rather than a rehoming centre. This is due to the number of cats taken in the previous year which are unsuitable for moving into new homes. These cats total just over 50. This has resulted in us being unable to accept a great number of cats coming into our care and we have concentrated on cats in the most danger.

Our intake of dogs has been restricted by the lack of foster homes. Again, we have concentrated on dogs in the greatest need.

We have decided we need to review our situation for the coming year with a view to improving our ability to cater for cats and dogs in need of our help. Obviously the inability to home cats in our care has had a drastic effect on our income from donations.

Independent Examiner's Report on the Accounts of Wild Acre Rescue
