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# Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

To preserve and protect the health of sufferers of autoimmune conditions and diseases by:

- promoting research for the public benefit into developing treatments and funding a cure for autoimmune conditions and diseases, including their prevention, and to disseminate the useful results of such research;
- ii. relieving sickness amongst persons who are suffering from an autoimmune condition or disease; and
- iii advancing the education of the public in general on the subject of autoimmune conditions and diseases.

The charity made two donations to the University of Liverpool in September 2018.

The first (£6260) was a contribution to the costs of investigating serum protein expression in patients with juvenile onset systemic Lupus erythematosus pre- and post-puberty, and covered the cost of 8 multiplex plates to run a 71 plex assay and the cost to use the facility to run the assay.

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit)

The second (£7500) was a contribution to the costs of investigating systemic inflammation in cystic fibrosis, and covered the cost of monocyte isolation kits, cell culture media, plastic ware, lab supplies, life cell imaging (antibodies, plastic supplies, facility fees), protein detection (MSD assays, alternatively CBAs), qPCR supplies (Primers, polymerase, reverse transcription) and DNA methylation assays.
