During the period 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019 Fountain of life was active in the following areas

In June 2018 Mark Provis travelled to Ziguinchor, Senegal, where we drilled our first two boreholes. A drilling team from Hope 2 Others International (H2O) in Gambia travelled to Ziguinchor with the materials. They taught our team of drillers how to drill the borehole using the 'Auger system' and the 'drilling system' and how to construct the pump to extract the water from the borehole.

Between July and December the H2O drilling team returned twice more to Ziguinchor, bringing more materials each time. They continued to work alongside and train our team of drillers. Together they completed another 7 wells in and around Ziguinchor, bringing the total number of completed wells to 9.

In January 2019 Mark travelled to Ziguinchor again to meet with the drilling team and visit the sites of the completed wells. Mark was able to visit 8 out of the 9 wells (the 9th is at the coast near Cap Skirring and he didn't have time to get out there).

There was also a YWAM DTS outreach team from YWAM Bridges of Life in France in Ziguinchor at the same time as Mark. We were able to demonstrate how we drill boreholes and construct the pumps to them. Mark taught them about the importance of good hygiene, especially hand washing, and how to make Tippy Taps. The team then went on to construct a number of Tippy Taps around Ziguinchor and passed on the message of the importance of good hygiene.

In February/March Mark successfully completed a free online course offered by the SDG Academy called Water: Addressing the global crisis. It focused on Sustainable Development Goal 6 (clean water and sanitation) and how we can ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all.

During the last 12 months we have continued to try and grow our online presence to reach more people through the website and social media.

We have also continued to build and maintain links with people we have previously worked with in the field.

The Trustees' policy is not to hold capital reserves, although inevitably some balances are held over the financial year end, where expenditure has been planned but not completed.

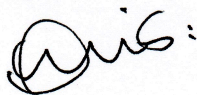
