Structure, governance and management

The Charitable Incorporated Organisation was formed on 14 May 2018 and took over the affairs of Jigsaw which formerly operated as a non-registered charity on the same date.

Jigsaw Events CIO is a registered charity in England and Wales under reference 1178363

The first trustees were appointed on the formation of the Charity. Additional trustees may be appointed by the members or the trustees. At the first annual meeting of the members of the Charity all trustees shall retire from office. At subsequent annual meetings one third of the trustees shall retire from office.

Objectives and activities

The charities' objectives are to provide social and leisure opportunities for the benefit of people living in the Black Country and Birmingham, in particular but not exclusively people with a learning disability, those experiencing financial hardship or other difficult circumstances, with the object of increasing their social networks, promoting independence and increasing community inclusion.

It does this through delivering a programme of regular and one off social and leisure activities that our members request.

Financial review

When the Charity was formed it took over the funds of Jigsaw. These funds were initially used to fund the charity's work together with some fundraising and small donations. The Charity would however find it difficult to operate without grant income. Fortunately we were able to obtain two grants in the period, one from People's Health and one from Awards for all. The People's Health receipt was part of a larger grant over a two year period from January 2019 whereas the amount received from Awards for all was to provide funding for the year ended 31st March 2020. Whilst the charity has sufficient funding to operate in 2020, the trustees are aware that more long-term funding is required to ensure that the Charity can operate successfully beyond 2020. The trustees are currently pursuing additional grant funding to ensure that the Charity can operate over the next four years.
