STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Gema Trust is an unincorporated charity established by a Trust Deed dated 17th September 1991 and was registered with the Charity Commission on 21st November 1991.

The Trustees deal with the day-to-day management of the Charity, including administration of donations. The Trustees undertake much of the work themselves and only employ such professional support as is necessary to operate effectively.

The Trustees have the power to spend or retain the income. The Charity does not actively fundraise and seeks to continue its charitable work through careful stewardship of its existing resources and providing donations to the trust that have been made by the trustees.

Under the terms of the Trust Deed, Mr Gerald Kirsh is entitled to appoint trustees to the Charity.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

In setting the objectives and planning the activity of the Charity, the Trustees have given careful consideration to the Charity Commissioners general guidance on public benefit.

The objects of the Charity are for the Trustees to pay or apply the Charity's fund and income for the benefit or in furtherance of such charitable purposes, charitable institutions or charitable foundations as the trustees may determine.

Public Benefit and impact

The Foundation is mindful of its obligations to meet the Public Benefit criterion and to be transparent, to this end it makes donations for charitable purposes, for education and training, the achievement of health or savings of lives, for the prevention of relief of poverty, overseas aid and famine relief and for religious activities.

TRUSTEES' REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2018

FINANCIAL REVIEW, ACHIVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The attached financial statements show the current state of the finances, which the Trustees consider to be sound. During the year the Charity received £45,125 (2017: £10,562) from donations from Trustees. Total resources expended amounted to £6,588 (2017: £9,645) leaving £39,824 (2017: £1,287) in funds carried forward to the next financial year after taking into account an opening balance of £1,287 (2017: £370).

At the balance sheet date the Charity does not have any financial commitments.

During the past year the Charity supported a number of charities including The United Synagogue, British Friends of the New Synagogue and The West End Great Synagogue.

TRUSTEES' RESPONSIBILITIES IN RELATION TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The Trustees are responsible for preparing a Trustee's annual report and financial statements in accordance with applicable law and the United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice).

The law applicable to charities in England and Wales requires the charity Trustees to prepare financial statements for each year, which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charity and of the incoming resources and application of resources of the Foundation for that period. In preparing the financial statements, the Trustees are required to:

- · Make judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent.

• State whether applicable accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures that must be disclosed and explained in the financial statements.

• Prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume the Foundation will continue in existence.

The Trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records that disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Foundation and to enable them to ensure that the financial Statements comply with the Charities Act 2011, the applicable Charities (Accounts and Reports) Regulations and the provision of the Trust Deed.

They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Foundation and taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.
