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REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES For The Year Ended 31 January 2019

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 January 2019. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives

The trustees must apply the income of the charity in furthering the following objects:

- 1) For such or any charitable purpose for the general benefit of the inhabitants of the town of Northampton (for which provision is not made from public rates or taxes)
- 2) The relief of financial hardship among people living or working in the town of Northampton by providing:
- The relief of financial hardship, either generally or individually of people living in the area of benefit.
- By making grants of money for providing or paying for items, services or facilities for the relief of the sick or poor living in Northampton either generally or individually through the provision of grants, goods or services.
- 3) To advance in life and help young people through:
- The provision of recreational and leisure time activities provided in the interest of social welfare designed to improve their condition of life.
- Providing support and activities which develop their skills, capacities and capabilities to enable them to participate in society as mature and responsible individuals.
- 4) The relief of financial needs and suffering among victims of natural or other kinds of disaster in the form of money (or other means deemed suitable) for persons, bodies, organisation and/or countries affected including the provision of medical aid. The relief and assistance of people in any part of the world who are the victims of war or natural disaster, trouble, or catastrophe in particular by the supply of medical aid to such persons.
- 5) Rotary Foundation.
- 6) Such or any other charitable purposes as the trustees shall from time to time in their discretion decide with reference to the rotary clubs of Northampton Nene Valley, Northampton, Northampton Becket, Northampton West and Northampton Apollo.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

The charity has been formed to provide a charitable vehicle to operate the annual Dragon Boat Racing festival on Billing Aquadrome and any other suitable function.

The Dragon Boat Racing festival has been successfully organised by the charity for the last twelve years.

The charity has also organised their annual Swimarathon, which is now into it's sixth year and will host a Santa run for the first year in December 2019.

The 2018 Dragon Boat challenge was very close to being loss making as it was held on the day of the World Cup final. As a result entries, and sponsorship were both well down.

Due to problems encountered with the 2018 Dragon Boat challenge it was decided not to go ahead with the 2019 Dragon Boat challenge as we couldn't be sure of getting enough entries.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

The Rotary Clubs of Northampton Charitable Trust Fund is a charitable trust created and governed by deed dated 6th June 2008. It is registered as a charity with the Charity Commission.

Governance

The Charitable Trust is administered by the trustees.

There must be at least three trustees. Apart from the first trustee, every trustee must be appointed for a term of four years by a resolution of the trustees passed at a special meeting.

Trustees must hold at least two ordinary meetings each year. No business shall be conducted at a meeting of the trustees unless at least one third of the total number of trustees at the time or two trustees (whichever is the greater) are present throughout the meeting.

At meetings, decisions must be made by a majority of the trustees present and voting on the question.

Management

The trustees may delegate any of their powers or functions to a committee of two or more trustees.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
