The objects of the CIO are to advance the Christian religion by the restoration, preservation, repair, maintenance, improvement and beautification of:

- a) The Parish Church of St Edmund, King & Martyr, Hardingstone in the Diocese of Peterborough (hereinafter called "the Church") and the Churchyard belonging to the Church and any other buildings, structures and properties which are the responsibility of the Parochial Church Council of the Parish of St Edmund, King & Martyr (including but not by way of limitation any boundaries, paths, accesses, fences and walls). In this document the Church, Churchyard and other such structures, buildings and properties are together called "the Church Properties"; and
- b) The monuments, fittings, fixtures, stained glass, furniture, ornaments and chattels of the Church Properties.

Section D Achievements and performance Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year objectives.

The charity pamphleted the whole of the village of Hardingstone and attracted over 30 people to an initial meeting to explain its aims and

The charity was formally launched on 2nd & 3rd June 2018 with the ringing of the church bells, an exhibition about the church building, a performance by the Hardingstone Players, refreshments, family activities and a Hymnathon.

The initial membership drive attracted 30 regular contributors and many generous donations.

An exhibition 'Honouring Hardingstone's Heroes' was mounted in the church from September's Heritage weekend until Remembrance Sunday. marking the centenary of the end of World War One.

Throughout Advent to Twelfth Night, we had 'Lights for a Loved One' decorating a yew tree at the entrance to the churchyard, with commemorative candles displayed inside the church.

Just over £6,000 was collected which raised £5,670 after expenses. We have a solid platform on which to build.

The first request from the church to help with a fabric project was received after the period end.
