Under the direction of the South-East Coast Ambulance service (SECAMB), during the calendar year 2018 nine responders attended over 400 incidents over an area from Hadlow Down to Punnetts Town and beyond, and from Mayfield to Horam. The Trustees would record their appreciation of the sterling efforts of the team leader, Hannah Crush who succeeded Theo Parfitt, deputy Andy Bodkin, training supervisor Andy McGarvey and the other Responders who dedicated so much of their time to this important service to the community. Thanks also go to Phil Williams for developing the First Responder database (FReD) which records the activity of all Responders.

The Trustees plan to recruit, train and equip additional Responders to bring the operating strength of the organisation to fifteen. We shall concentrate on maintaining training with specialised equipment to meet the increasing skill-sets now demanded. We shall continue to give public demonstrations of Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation and to contribute to the installation of defibrillators within the community.

The requirements of the Charity Commission have been met.

The Trustees wish to record their appreciation of the continuing encouragement we receive from so many organisations within the community.


