The Charity was established on 21st September 1988.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

The trustees have a duty to identify and review the risks to which the charity is exposed and to ensure appropriate controls are in place to provide reasonable assurance against fraud and error.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

Radha Madhav Society (UK) is a non-profit, religious, educational & charitable organisation. It serves as the United Kingdom's affiliate of Jagadguru Kripalu Parishat (JKP), which is the worldwide mission of His Divine Excellency Bhakti Yoga Rasavatara Shri 1008 Jagadguru Shri Kripalu Ji Maharaj, the supreme acharya of this age. The JKP trusts aims to contribute to the material well-being of mankind by providing orphans, widows and other needy and deprived persons. The trust has established many educational institutions, charitable hospitals & regularly organise medical relief camps for the deprived and needy.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 5 APRIL 2019

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Significant activities

Discourses based on the wisdom of ancient Hindu scriptures were arranged in halls and temples of major cities within UK, and home 'Bhakti Yoga Sankeertans' were arranged and conducted by HH Dr. Bageeshwari Devi during the tour of the various cities in UK. All the major Hindu festivals were also celebrated either at the Society's main centre at 109 Edgehill Road Leicester, or at a Hindu temple or a devotee's residence. In addition there were some major public discourses such as the 'Can we change our destiny' in Edinburgh, 'Parenting with Practical Wisdom' at Swindon Cultural Centre, 'Karma Binds Karma Frees' in Sindhi Centre, London and Janmastami Celebrations at Middlesbrough Hindu temple that benefited the public at large.

The popular series of talks on Vedic scriptures by Jagadguru Kripaluji Maharaj have continued to be broadcast on Global television channels for the benefit of the community.

On 16th December 2018, JKP received the prestigious "Swasth Hindustan" award for providing excellent and free health care services to the society through Jagadguru Kripalu Chikitsalaya hospitals. President of JKP, Sushri Dr Vishakha Tripati Ji, was honoured with the 'World Icon Award 'for her exemplary philanthropic work of JKP. The trust runs a 100% charitable school/college for underprivileged girls, three large hospitals that provide free holistic medical care to all those in need and a poor relief fund to give important necessities to the impoverished. Almost 4 million lives have been helped due to these amazing efforts. Other awards received in the past were UP state Mahotsav (2015), Nelson Mandela Award (2014). Nari Today Award (2013) and Rajiv Gandhi Excellence Award (2012).

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

The biggest spending was donation towards charitable trust established by Jagadguru Kripalu Parishat in India which not only helps the poor in the rural areas but also has established charitable hospitals and schools. Just over £400,0000 were donated to these worthy charitable causes.

The other major spending was towards the new extension and refurbishment of the property, 109 Edgehill Road, Leicester, owned by Radha Madhav Society. Also, there were money spent in broadcasting the spiritual talks based on Vedic scriptures by our Spiritual Founder Jagadguru Shri Kripaluji Maharaj on Aastha International TV. Finances were also used for organising programmes and for costs of Dr. Bageeshwari Devi's trips to UK, including transportation and subsistence during her stay in UK.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Principal funding sources

The two major sources of finances are the 'monthly donations' that have been setup as standing orders by devotees/members of the society and 'ad hoc donations'. Members of the society have generously pledged and donated towards our society charitable activities in India and for broadcast of lectures on TV within UK, USA and Canada. The ad hoc donations for this year reached just over £348,000.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 5 APRIL 2019

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, the Charities Act 2011 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

INCOMING RESOURCES

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

RESOURCES EXPENDED

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end date are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

TAXATION

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

FUND ACCOUNTING

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
