Structure, Governance and Management

The charity is controlled by its governing document, and it has six trustees who are re-appointed annually at the Annual General Meeting.

Objectives and Activities

The objectives of the charity are as follows:

- Promotion of health and relief of sick, ill and disabled people;
- Education of public on all health matters; and
- Conservation of environment where pollution has an effect on health of population.

The activities of the charity are as follows:

- Operation of free advisory clinics;
- Administration of orphan foster care system; and
- Distribution of clothes and food and the provision of transport for the disabled.

Achievements and performance

- Enlarging a 'Foster Care' system;
- Increasing patient capacity in free clinic;
