Expenditure in total was £52k with £43k spent on school purchases including iPads and IT, playground equipment and furniture, sports, cultural trips, religious books and trips, and a defibrillator with training.

£5.5k was used to celebrate the school's 125th anniversary along with other children's parties.



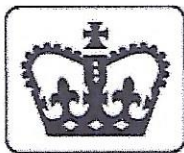
