#### **Financial Review**

**Summary:** In 2018 our overall income reduced by 3.7% over the previous year, whilst our total expenditure was down by 6%. Whilst there was a surplus of £2,674 of income over expenditure, the apparent solvency was flattered considerably by late receipt of 2018 invoices which consequently were not paid in the financial year.

**Income:** Our two main income streams of Voluntary Giving (£48,909) and Hall/Room rental fees (£34,744) were at almost the same level as in 2017. The overall reduction in total income of nearly £4,000 was mainly the result of the non-repeat of a 2017 bequest of £1,000 and the receipt of only three quarterly rental payments from "Tom Metcalf Centre", leaving us £3,275 short in our financial year.

**Expenditure:** Overall expenditure was considerably lower because of fewer "Repairs & Maintenance" payments, and also because November and December gas invoices and refuse collection bills were not received in 2018. These were paid in early January 2019. There were also certain charitable collections just prior to Christmas remaining in the current account awaiting payment in the New Year. All of these factors contribute to an apparent reduction in overall expenditure but make for a difficult start to 2019.

**Fabric Fund:** The balance in this "Unrestricted Designated Fund" reduced by £1,149 in 2018. This was the result of transfers-out of £3,062 for "Repairs & Maintenance", offset by a transfers-in of £1,900 (5% of the Hall/Room letting fees), and interest accrued of £13. For the purpose of calculating the Hall/Room letting fees transfer, the non-receipt of the  $4^{th}$  quarter TMC rental was ignored and included in the overall 5% calculation, increasing the transfer by £164. During the year an appeal to the congregation for the purchase of a wireless microphone system raised £672 which was transferred to the Fabric Fund on an on-going basis pending the purchase in June when it was transferred back to the current account and contributed to the overall cost of the system.

**Net Assets:** It is important to highlight the significant proportion ( 58%) of our net assets of £41,839 which are in "Restricted Funds" (notably Cornerstone, LIGHT service and Foodbox) which can only be used for their designated purpose.

**Conclusion:** A relatively stable year, but with erratic payment and receipt patterns at the tail-end of the year. There are indications that we face financial challenges in 2019.

My thanks are due for the significant contribution of Ivan Hurcum and Chris Gough to the Finance Team, and especially Ivan for weekly banking and in his role as Freewill Offering Secretary in compilation of our annual Gift-Aid reclaim from HMRC.

#### 1. Notes

- (i) The financial statements of the PCC have been prepared in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2006 and the Charities Act 2011. These financial statements have also applied the guidance from the new Charities SORP (FRS102) that is effective for all year ends from 31 December 2015 onwards and replaces the Charities Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP 2005).
- (ii) These financial statements are prepared using the receipts and payments basis and as such exclude income earned during the financial year that have not been received as at 31 December as well as amounts owing from obligations entered into during the financial year for which payments have not been raised.
- (iii) The funds specified on page 4 represent all the funds of the PCC including those which are subject to special restrictions regarding their use.

The St. Peter's Fabric Fund has been designated by the PCC as monies to be used towards the development of the fabric of the church. The PCC has agreed a policy to commit the PCC to transfer 5% of annual letting income to the Fabric Fund with a further review in September of each year to agree whether a top up payment can be made from any surplus generated from unrestricted funds.

The PCC is committed to maintaining a sustainable reserve to cover any future requirements relating to the development of the fabric of the church.

- (iv) Assets recognised but not valued in the Statement of Assets and Liabilities include:
  - Moveable church furnishings held by the Church Wardens on special trust for the PCC and which require a faculty for disposal.
  - Other fixtures, fittings and office equipment of which the PCC is free to dispose of without faculty and where the original cost exceeded £1,000.
- (v) In addition to the funds specified on page 4, there is a "Stent" deposit account used solely at the discretion of the Vicar and Church Wardens. The PCC has no control over these funds and is not directly accountable for them. This is a 'connected charity' to St. Peter's Church and is outside the scope of these financial statements.
- (vi) Expenses paid to clergy may include a small immaterial proportion that relates to their function as PCC members. No other payments were made to PCC members.
