Summary of Activities

All the Almshouses have been fully occupied throughout the year. The resident's contributions amounted to £24,572. The Trustees have reviewed the Resident's Contributions as in previous years and a small increase made as of 1st April 2019.

The operating costs were £18,651 making the comparative operating cost in line with previous years when allowing for the cost of the Quinquennial inspection. The Almshouses where found to be in good condition following repair and improvements carried out since the last inspection in 2013 with only minor repairs recommended.

Loan repayments amounted to £5,416 purchase of investments to £1,600. Miscellaneous payments amounted to £350 resulting in a surplus of £9,559 of income over expenditure. The closing bank balance stands at £33,536...
