

Annual Report September 2019

Welcome to our second annual account of the Charitable Incorporated Organisation.

It has been quite a year of change not least because our former chair, Mr Charles Wood, died on Sunday 16th September 2018. I had only met Charles once (at my interview) but many of you will be aware of his amazing energy and enthusiasm for our charitable enterprise which enabled us to get Active and In Touch (A&IT) as far as it has. Our staff, volunteers and members as well as many people in the town itself knew Charles as a committed and forthright, active person. He is sadly missed by many and our thoughts are still with Jane (his widow) and his wider family who still grieve.

The following day I became a Trustee but also chair of Trustees and I thank so many people for the privilege this entails. It was and remains a privilege of mixed blessings as, again, on that same day, CSW South West, attended the Trustees meeting to announce that, due to Somerset County Council budget cuts, they were having to cut their own budgets and so our then Service Coordinator, Lucia Chadwick was made redundant.

The trustees then had decisions to make: Could we "go it alone"? Should we "go it alone"? How would we manage without Charles (from what I can gather he did everything!)? How could we restructure?

Between then and now there have been significant changes and these are summarised in the table (appendix A) but the most important of these are:

- 1. Lucia took over as Service Manager but since has resigned (leaving us at the end of July) so that she can further her career in counselling.
- 2. Dougie Brown was appointed to replace Lucia and started on 1st August.
- 3. We are developing our strategy for the next five years.
- 4. Our finances have been stretched and we are developing a financial and fund-raising strategy.
- 5. We have had to develop our own policies and this is on-going work.
