The Church meets for the public worship of God morning and evening on Sundays, and for Bible Study and prayer at the midweek meeting on Wednesdays. These meetings are mostly led by our minister, Pastor David Pfeiffer, and take place at our church premises.

Other activities have included :-

- Weekly (in term-time) sessions for the "Whaddon Lights" childrens choir, made up of children from the local area
- · Bi-weekly hymn singing at a local care home
- Bi-weekly ladies' meetings which involve bible study and refreshments
- Periodic "kids' fun days" for children from the local area
- Periodic international evenings for international students from the local university
- Periodic "Christianity Explored" courses
- Periodic "Discipleship Explored" courses

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The accounts show a deficit of £4,727, despite the fact that a grant of £11,000 was received in the year.

This has been financed by cash reserves inherited from the predecessor church.

One further grant has been received so far in the year to 31st March 2020, but the church is still not financially self-supporting. The elders are therefore continuing to seek external funding, while also hoping to increase giving from within the congregation.


