

Achievements and performance

These workshops have provided the young people with a stimulating activity using professional recording studio equipment. It has also increased their skill level in this area and provided a more responsible way of spending spare time. As is evident from research, the lack of structured activities in London has contributed, in some way, to crime and gang warfare. Those who are fortunate not to be caught up in crime are left idle and isolated. Unfortunately, the workshops have not been run on the scale that was envisaged because of the scarcity in funding.

Our mentoring programmes have allowed young people to connect with older members of the community and grow their confidence and selfesteem.

Our employment advice and training service has allowed young people who have problems with their cv compilation to have us look at it and help them make the necessary adjustments. In addition we are able to give them advice on the direction they ought to go down regarding work options according to their interest and experience.
