Chairpersons Maeldune Trust Report to 31 March 2019

Dear Trustees

The attached accounts show twelve months trading to the end of March 2019.

Income

Our trading activities have shown a decrease over the previous year of £1,513.45 However our donations were up by £815.54. This was because of the WW1 Danger Tree Exhibition and other donations. We are now charged £5.00 a month for using CAF bank. Our visitor numbers are up by 192. Trend information shows that people are spending less and cutting their spending. We are fortunate that the grant from Maldon Town Council has remained unchanged.

Expenses

Our main expenditure is staff costs and utilities. Heating a Grade 1 Listed building during cold periods to allow our staff and volunteers and visitors to have a comfortable environment is not without its challenges and our heating costs have risen. We have successfully controlled other costs and they have increased by only £127.33. The year has resulted in a small loss of £509.53. Our profit last year was £1,131.25. As always, the future years are a challenge. We have a new Manager and staff with long service but our pool of volunteers is decreasing due to competition from other charities and so paid staff costs may rise.
