OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the charity are:

- To relieve poverty in the town of Swaffham by the provision of pensions
- Maintenance of religion in the town of Swaffham
- Improvement of the amenity of the town of Swaffham

In order to meet the objectives of the charity income is to be applied as follows:

- 5/9ths allocated to the pension fund
- 2/9ths allocated to the Swaffham Church Fabric account
- 1/9th allocated to the Churchwardens
- 1/9th allocated to the Town improvement fund

The charity is governed by its constitution, which was adopted in November 1976. It was registered as a charity with the Charity Commission in 1962.

1. Principal Accounting Policies

1.1 Basis of Preparation

These accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention with items recognised at cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant note(s) to these accounts.

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with:

- the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) issued on 16 July 2014
- and with the Charities Act 2011.

The charity constitutes a public benefit entity as defined by FRS 102.

1.2 Change in basis of accounting

There has been no change to the accounting policies since last year.

1.3 Changes to previous accounts

No changes have been made to accounts for previous years.

2. Accounting Policies

2.1 Incoming Resources

All income is recognised on a receivable basis. No income is shown net of expenditure.

2.2 Fund Accounting

Restricted funds are funds which are to used in accordance with specific restrictions imposed by donors or which have been raised by the charity for particular purposes. The cost of raising and administering such funds are charged against the specific fund. The aim and use of each restricted fund is set out in the notes to the financial statements.

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of general objectives of the charity and which have not been designated for other purposes.

2.3 Resources Expended

All expenditure is included on an accruals basis and is recognised when there is legal or constructive obligations to pay for expenditure. The charity is not registered for VAT and accordingly expenditure is shown gross of irrecoverable VAT.

Expenses are apportioned where necessary. Governance costs are those incurred in connection with administration of the charity.
