We promote humane behaviour towards animals by providing appropriate care, protection, treatment and security for the animals by reason of sickness, maltreatment, poor circumstances or ill usage and to educated the public in matters pertaining to animal welfare and the prevention of cruelty and suffering among animals.

		4) Our high style LWB van has helped us with easy collections of donated goods and we were able to do more house clearances swiftly and efficiently.	
		5) We held raffles throughout the year at our shops and found our customers loved to have a chance of winning the large boxes of goodies we had to offer.

and more and more people are contacting us having read our page first and also followed us on Facebook.
 We are lucky to have dedicated staff who all love cats and worked tirelessly last year to achieve our aims.
8) We didn't receive any general grants this year to help run our shelter. Our overheads have gone up so it becomes increasingly difficult without any outside help. All donations are gratefully received, however small.
9) Luckily we do have a building fund for grants specifically given only to replace our older wooden buildings, but our next new UPVC building will cost over £30,000 so we will be applying again to help our fund grow.
