FinCHE COMMUNITY GROUP became a CIO in December 2017. Prior to that it had been a small group of people who ran fund raising events to generate money for the purchase of children's play area equipment for the Villages of Finchingfield and Cornish Hall End in rural North Essex. The group funded the purchase of a Zip Wire for Cornish Hall End and two pairs of 5-side goals for both villages. Following a survey of the two villages a clear desire for a Multi Use Games Area(MUGA) was identified. At this point it was decided to make the group a charity if possible. The charity is a CIO Foundation consisting of 5 trustees. We are in discussion with the Parish Council the Sole Trustee of Sports Field about converting a part of the Sports Field into a MUGA using grants and donations. We have been looking to increase the number of trustees, but unfortunately we have not found anybody suitable.

To promote for the benefit of the inhabitants of Finchingfield and Cornish Hall End, Essex and the surrounding area. The main activities undertaken for the public benefit can be divided into fund raising activities, and activities funded by Finche. The main fund raising activity is the Finchingfield 3Legged Race. This event was run by Finche before it became a charity. It takes place in July on a Sunday. The event has taken the place of the Village Fete. Volunteers help the trustees to run the actual race and the numerous stalls around the Village Green. The day has become a very well visited event and local businesses as well as the charity benefit. The number of competitors in the race has trebled over the last two years. There is also now a section for under 8s and 8 to 16.

The club was originally founded in the 1920-21 season by World War 1 Veterans. After several years in abeyance the team was reformed by a group of young men from the village. FinCHE gave a loan to the club for a set of mobile full size goals, and a grant towards the cost of start up. The football team won the invitation cup in its first season and has a following of about 20 fans at home and away matches weather permitting. The team has become a focus point for the village.
