Achievements and Performance

In 2018-2019, the PTA funded a wide range of school activities including:

- Tablet computer devices for the school
- School T shirts for all year 6 pupils
- "Toys in Space" Classtronauts event
- · History workshop event
- Classroom equipment

The Thornhill Foundation is working towards longer term goals to fund refurbishment of the EYFS classrooms / facilities and to build a new school library, both due to complete in the 2019/20 tax year.

The key achievement of the Thornhill Foundation was in the commissioning of the Library build for 2019.
