About Us

Festival Church Chester (FCC) is a Christian church situated in the centre of the city of Chester, committed to serving its local community and giving people the opportunity to explore the Christian faith. FCC is a member of Assemblies of God in Great Britain and a member of the Evangelical Alliance UK.

In addition to regular weekly (Sunday) church services, the church runs a number of midweek activities for all ages, maintaining a Christian presence in the community.

The church is involved with and supports several local and international Christian ministries.

Review of 2018 / 2019

The church continues to experience growth across all age groups. This is beginning to present challenges in terms of space, but is something the church actively seeking to remedy through a variety of solutions.

The Community Hall and Festival Coffee are in regular use by local voluntary organisations and members of the public. Festival Coffee continues to develop and regularly receives excellent reviews for its standard of coffee and service. During this period, a comprehensive review of the coffee shop has been completed, which demonstrated that the coffee shop is meeting a particular need, but that to maintain this some aspects of the staffing structure and opening hours need to be adjusted.

Our Festival Grants project received a positive number of applications. Working in partnership with Chester Voluntary Association (CVA), the church was able to assist a good number of small charitable organisations in their work to alleviate social isolation within Chester.

In the September of 2018, we launched an internship programme offering both weekday and weekend placements for people interested in serving in church ministry. With three participants, this has proved to be a worthwhile venture, and something to be considered further for the future.

At the beginning of 2019, we invited Mr John Finkelde of Grow a Healthy Church to conduct a consultation in order to highlight good practice and suggest areas for improvement. This was a beneficial exercise in terms of receiving an objective outside opinion, together with pointers for future practice.

During the review period, Mr Richard Tavernor stepped down from his role as Trustee. The board of Trustees placed on record their thanks for the service and expertise he brought to the board.

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The Year Ahead (2019 / 2020)

Meetings

The charity trustees and the Senior Leadership Team will continue to meet throughout the year to carry out their respective responsibilities.
