## About YACnCAY

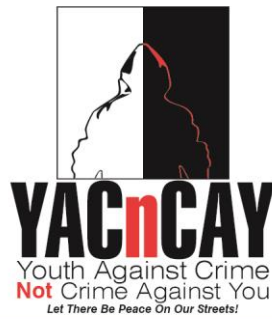
