We have a dedicated team of 19 volunteers, 11 of them receive very minimal remuneration to cover their out of pocket expenses. We are really grateful to all of them for their services.

We are helping with construction and running of two small Madrasas In the remote rural area of Balagonj, Sylhet, Bangladesh, namely Darul Uloom Sunapur Rupapur and Jamia Rahmania Madrasa. Once completed, the building will be used as a multi-purpose centre for all the people in that locality. We also helped educate and train 150 girls in Puti Zuri Girls Madrasa in Hobigonj, Bangladesh.

Mumin Aid is also collaborating with Blue Ink Trust to build a school in the Sudhar Nagar area of India, which will provide education to the most deprived children.

On behalf of Charity and the Masjid we sponsored 50 families in Ramadhan in Bangladesh and Pakistan to have a Poverty Free Ramadhan. The people were personally identified by our Musallis who passed on this Ramadan gifts to the relevant people. The cost was only £50.00 for an average family.

Over 90 % of our work is in England concentrating on English projects. It will increase further over the coming years. We have supported small projects in England, Bangladesh, India, Pakistan and Myanmar (Ruhinga people).

We have sponsored over 35 students to become Hafiz in Bangladesh. We intent to increase the Scheme of Sponsoring Huffaz in Bangladesh, India and Pakistan.

We have now taken house building, providing water pumps and school building projects in Bangladesh. This year Mumin Aid provided Nine Water pumps and three houses.

Trustees have approved this report and the accompanying account on 16th December 2019.
