Objectives and Activities

The mission of Amna Refugee Healing Network is to provide healing and support for refugees through therapeutic and community-based programs, aiding individuals and families affected by displacement and trauma.

For this reporting period, Amna Refugee Healing Network did not engage in any financial or programmatic activities, as the organization was still in the process of establishing essential infrastructure, including the setup of an operational bank account.

Structure, Governance, and Management

Amna Refugee Healing Network operates as a Charitable Incorporated Organization (CIO) and is registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales (Charity Number: 1203454).
