2. Activities and achievements

Principal activities

The principal activity of the trust is the provision of long-term housing for six local, needy and aged persons.

Funding strategy

Costs are funded by investment income and a monthly contribution from each tenant.

Maintenance

Maintenance of, and repairs to, the Almshouses is arranged by the Trustees. Costs include exterior window cleaning and gardening.

Achievements in 2019

Despite the sad loss of one tenant during 2019, the Trustees were able to maintain almost full occupancy until the commencement of the planned alterations in the autumn of 2019.

3. Policies

Reserves

The trustees' policy is to maintain income that either exceeds or matches the costs incurred in the operation of the charity.

As at 31st December 2019, unrestricted and restricted reserves totaled £189215 (2018: £119015).

6. The 2019 Project

Building works to extend the rear of each almshouse commenced in September 2019. The intention is to transform six small bed-sits into six one-bedroomed apartments with modern bathrooms, kitchens and individual heating systems. Costs to date amount to £189520 (2018: £12724).

The first tranche of £96316 of a bank loan of £250000 was received in November 2019.

7. Assets

The trustees do not hold any assets aside from;

- (1) cash accumulated and held in the bank;
- (2) the freehold land and buildings comprising the six almshouses with a current value of £1,250,000, the cost of which is indeterminable.
